Coach Accreditation is required for access to the mat area. Coach Accreditation will be issued by name and are non-transferable.</p> <p>All IJA coaches must be Garda Vetted. Parents or Volunteers will not be issued Coach Accreditation for this event.</p>

Anti- Doping	There is no Doping Control at this event.
Draw	Will be completed prior to event.
Competition Mode	<p>All minor competitors will have a minimum of two fights and either the pool system or double reperchage shall be used. For all other competitors, competition will be carried out according to the rules and sporting codes of the IJF/ EJU KO system.</p> <p>This is an All-Ireland event, so only members of the Irish Judo Association and the Northern Ireland Judo Federation can compete.</p> <p>All judoka must be affiliated members of the IJA/NIJF.</p>
Judogi & Judogi Control	<p>As this is a National Event <u>white judogi only</u> must be worn and appropriate footwear must be worn in the hall at all times. At weigh-in, please note judoka must weigh-in wearing appropriate clothing - judo pants for Boys & judo pants/tee-shirt for Girls.</p> <p>Women must wear a white non-transparent t-shirt. Bras must not have any hard pieces. Long hair must be tied up with the appropriate elastic band. Make up and jewellery are prohibited. Nails should be cut short.</p> <p>The judogi control will be performed by the referees.</p>
Insurance	<p>Each club is responsible for insuring its competitors against injury and third-party risk during the relevant period.</p> <p>The Irish Judo Association will not accept any liability for any loss or damage howsoever arising.</p>
