Statement re Covid 19 – Events & Activities**

Having considered the statement issued by the Government in relation to the Covid-19 pandemic, the Management of the Irish Judo Association have decided to cancel all judo activities for affiliated bodies within the IJA at provincial and national level and recommend that clubs cancel all judo activity. This comes into force with immediate effect until the 29th March. The timeline will be reviewed in line with Government and HSE guidance.
