<b>Anti- Doping</b>	There is no Doping Control at this event.
<b>Draw</b>	Will be completed prior to event.
<b>Competition Mode</b>	<p>All minor competitors will have a minimum of two fights and either the pool system or double reperchage shall be used. For all other competitors, competition will be carried out according to the rules and sporting codes of the IJF/ EJU KO system. This is an All-Ireland event, so only members of the Irish Judo Association and the Northern Ireland Judo Federation can compete.</p> <p><b>All judoka must be affiliated members of the IJA/NIJF.</b></p>
<b>Judogi &amp; Judogi Control</b>	<p>In an effort to assist in the return to competition, the requirement for a white judogi only will be waived for this event. The IJA asks that judoka wear a white judogi where possible but a blue judogi will be permitted in the absence of a white judogi.</p> <p><b><u>NB This will be the last event where leniency re White Judogi is given.</u></b></p> <p>Female competitors must wear a white non-transparent t-shirt. Bras must not have any hard pieces. Long hair must be tied up with the appropriate elastic band. Make up and jewellery are prohibited. Nails should be cut short for all judokas.</p> <p>The judogi control will be performed by the referees.</p>
<b>Insurance</b>	<p>Each club is responsible for insuring its competitors against injury and third-party risk during the relevant period.</p> <p>The Irish Judo Association will not accept any liability for any loss or damage howsoever arising.</p>
