We are pleased to announce the start of Semester 2 for 2023 of

Undergraduate Certificate as Judo Instructor - UCJI

The UCJI course is available in Arabic, English, French, Japanese, Georgia, Hungarian, Polish, Portuguese, Russian, Slovakian, Spanish and Turkish.

All the previous qualifications (Instructor – Level 1) obtained by graduated students will remain valid. Still, those who want to upgrade to the newly accredited courses need only apply for the online phase and get the Undergraduate Certificate Judo Instructor qualification.

COURSE TIMELINE

- **First day:** Monday, 7 August 2023
- **Last day:** Sunday midnight, 10 December 2023

The IJF Academy accepts applications for the UCJI course until **Sunday, 16 July 2023**

COURSE FEES

1. **USD 900 - NEW** students to Undergraduate Certificate Judo Instructor
This fee does not include the participation cost of the practical session! The students or the Federation must cover flights and the cost of board and accommodation during the practical session.
Practical sessions for the UCJI courses will be organised in 2024. The location and dates will be published in the News and Resources section on the IJF Academy platform.
2. **USD 550 - UPGRADE** students to the Undergraduate Certificate Judo Instructor course (online only).

The course fee must be paid before the first day of the course!

IMPORTANT DEADLINES AND NOTICE

1. Level 1 – Instructor Course

The Level 1 – Instructor Course is valid as the IJF Coach Licence (see attached copy of the letter).

There are still many students who did not yet complete this course.

The conditions to qualify through the Level 1 – Instructor Course are as follows:

- successfully passed the Online digital Test (ODT) by the 30th of June 2023
- successfully completed the practical session by the 31st of December 2023
- after the 31st of December 2023, the students who have not successfully completed the Level 1 – Instructor course will be removed from the database and have to reapply for the UCJI course in March 2024.

2. TEMPORARY LICENCE

The second-semester online phase will end on the 10th of December, 2023. Those who fulfil the following requirements will be granted a “Temporary Licence”:

- successfully passed all online modules and
- successfully passed the Online Digital Test (ODT)

On the 15th of August, 2024, all Temporary Licences will no longer be valid. The students can still obtain the full licence by completing the practical session.
