Agreed Parameters

- ✓ Top 2 players per Province in each weight category for each Age Band. These players to be decided by each Province prior to the event. All Players must have current IJA membership for 2024.
- ✓ Provincial Councils will email IJA Competitions Organisers their list of players at least 14 days prior to the event so they can prepare registration and publish entry list.
- ✓ **Provincial Councils/Coaches need to ensure that their players will make their weight as player cannot 'move up' to next weight (unless there is a 'gap' for their Province in the next weight up). Players can only move up to the next weight category.**
- ✓ There is NO entry fee for players here as each Province is funding the cost equally to run the event.
- ✓ For the weigh-in, both male & female judoka must weigh in wearing contest legal judogi trousers and plain round neck t-shirt/rash guard. A weight allowance of **1kg** will apply to all judoka. This weight tolerance only applies this year and will be reviewed.
- ✓ Girls must wear a white non-transparent t-shirt. Bras must not have any hard pieces. Long hair must be tied up with the appropriate elastic band. Make up and jewellery are prohibited. Nails for all players should be cut short. The judogi control will be performed by the referees.
- ✓ The competition will be held in White judogi only for all categories. Female players can opt to wear Blue judogi if they so wish.
- ✓ Medals (Gold x 1, Silver x 1, Bronze x 1 or 2) will be presented shortly after the completion of each weight category.
- ✓ Pool System will be used as follows:
 - **8 Players** – 2 Pools of 4. Top two players in each pool qualify for semi-final.
 - **7 Players** – 1 Pool of 3 and 1 Pool of 4. Top two players in each pool qualify for semi-final.
 - **6 Players** – 2 Pools of 3. Top two players in each pool qualify for semi-final.
 - **5/4/3 Players** – 1 Pool with 'Round Robin'.
 - **2 Players** – Best of 3 contests.
 - **The contest programme will decide the 'draw'.**
