Please be advised that the closing date for entries will be Monday 6th May 2024 at 11.59pm. There will be no late entries accepted. The automated entry system will shut at 11.59pm.</p>



Coaches	<p>In order for Coach Accreditation to be issued; only IJA/EJU/IJF approved coaches can obtain Accreditation. <u>Please note only IJA affiliated & qualified (Level 1 or higher) coaches with valid Vetting & Safeguarding & First Aid Certificates will be issued with Coach Accreditation for this event. NIJF Coaches should bring their coach cards/books with them on the day.</u> Coach Accreditation will be ready for collection at the official Weigh-in following closure of online entry, (Saturday night weigh-in or Sunday morning weigh-in for collection). Coach Passes issued are based on Valid Active Coaches listed in club database subject to a maximum of 4 coach passes per club if applicable. Parents or Volunteers will not be issued Coach Accreditation for this event.</p> <p>ONLY ONE COACH ALLOWED MATSIDE PER PLAYER.</p>

Accommodation	<p>There is no official hotel for this event. The event location is in Co Meath for those looking for local accommodation.</p>
Transfer	<p>All individuals must arrange their own transport.</p>
Media	<p>Any person who wishes to photograph the event should apply for accreditation at the official Weigh-in. This is in line with Best Practice regarding Safeguarding for Children in Sport. Media Accreditation will only be issued to those who complete the accreditation form; ID may be required so please bring driver's licence/passport. Please adhere to this policy. A Camera Registration Form is contained at the bottom of this document.</p>
Anti- Doping	<p>Shall be conducted in conjunction with Sport Ireland Anti-Doping Rules which are compliant with the World Anti-Doping Code and tests shall be conducted in line with best practices.</p>



Draw	Will be done prior to the event.
Competition Mode	<p>All minor competitors will have a minimum of two fights and either the pool system or double repechage shall be used. For all other competitors, competition will be carried out according to the rules and sporting codes of the IJF/ EJU KO system. Competitors must be current members of the Irish Judo Association or the Northern Ireland Judo Federation.</p> <p>This competition is only for valid members of the Irish Judo Association & Northern Ireland Judo Federation.</p>
Judogi & Judogi Control	<p>The competition will be held in white judogi only for all minor, pre-cadet and cadet categories. Those competing in the junior and senior categories must have a white and blue judogi. This will be strictly enforced.</p> <p>Women must wear a white non-transparent t-shirt. Bras must not have any hard pieces. Long hair must be tied up with the appropriate elastic band. Make up and jewellery are prohibited. Nails should be cut short. The judogi control will be performed by the referees.</p> <p>Footwear must be worn in the arena at all times other than when competing.</p> <p>Only back patches with 'IRL & NIR' will be permitted, no other country code can be noted on the back patch.</p>
Insurance	Each club is responsible for insuring its competitors against injury and third-party risk during the relevant period. The Irish Judo Association will not accept any liability for any loss or damage howsoever arising.
